Race to Erase MS benefit gig marks only second time band has played without Starchild



Kiss performed at the annual Race to Erase MS benefit in Los Angeles Friday under highly unusual circumstances: The band played as a trio for only the second time in their history as guitarist Paul Stanley was a last-minute cancellation after tearing a bicep tendon.

"Tore my bicep tendon. Surgery reattached it with a screw and stitches to anchor in place. Not much I can do now," Stanley [posted on Facebook](#) just hours before Kiss' benefit gig, which helped raise \$250,000 toward multiple sclerosis research.

Tommy Thayer and drummer Eric Singer played the four-song set at the Beverly Hilton without Stanley, who previously only missed a 2007 Kiss concert in San Jacinto, California after he was sidelined by a heart issue, [Blabbermouth reports](#). With the Starchild recuperating, Kiss' short set focused entirely on Simmons-sung tracks like "Cold Gin," "Deuce," "Rock and Roll All Nite" and "Calling Dr. Love."

Fortunately, Stanley's surgery isn't expected to interfere with or postpone any of the dates on Kiss' [recently announced Freedom to Rock](#) tour, which kicks off July 7th in Boise, Idaho. "Thanks to my AMAZING doctor I WILL be great & ready to rock WAAAAYYYY before the tour! CAN'T WAIT," Stanley promised.

In 23 years, everyone from No Doubt to Earth, Wind and Fire to Fitz and The Tantrums to Stevie Wonder have performed at the fundraiser that supports Davis's Center Without Walls program. Her org funds a network of doctors working towards prevention and an eventual cure for MS. They also give grants. The morning after the bash, Davis and the doctors from the Center will hold a [free Center Without Walls MS Forum](#) at the [Beverly Hilton](#), which is open to all, in order to talk about advances and patient care. Want to hang out with LL Cool J, Lea Michele, Ashley Tisdale, and rock out to KISS? Tickets are still available [here](#) for the April 15 Race to Erase MS honoring [Carolyn Rafaelian](#), Founder, CEO, and CCO of ALEX AND ANI. But before the big bash, we caught up with the Davises to get the scoop on this year's fundraiser and her hope of finding a cure.

How has the event changed since you started it as a ski race in Aspen decades ago?

It was definitely smaller then, and there was the matter of getting everyone to fly there. Then, it was about 600 people. Friday night there was a country western party, and the next day was the race. I live in L.A. and thought, "Why don't I have it here?" We did an Olympic-style thing at UCLA, it was around the time L.A. hosted the Olympics, and it's been in L.A. ever since—with the exception of once in Vegas. Now it is over a thousand guests.



How long does it take to put together?

It takes a concentrated nine months of your life. It's like having a baby. You have morning sickness in the beginning, and in the end you deliver a healthy baby.

How are you feeling?*

You know what, I honestly am feeling really well. I've had this disease for 24 years, and I know that every day I feel well, I knock on wood. So many people are not doing well. It's a tough disease and very unpredictable. My sister Dana, who has diabetes, has been diagnosed with MS, too. But when we started our first year in Aspen, there were no drugs on the market, no protocol, very little help. Today we are announcing the FDA approval of the 13th drug on the market. It's really exciting.

Race to Erase has one of the craziest live and silent auctions around. What's on the auction block this year?

There's tea with Sharon and Kelly Osbourne at the Peninsula, a private yacht in the Bahamas for five days, golfing with my husband and one of the members of Earth, Wind and Fire, dinner for 20 at Mr Chow. Things like that. Items you can't get anywhere else.

Every year you end the evening singing *Lean On Me*. Why?

Driving in my car after being diagnosed with MS, the song *Lean On Me* came on the radio and it hit me in a big, emotional way. We've sung it at the end of the night for years. This year the boy band Emblem3 is singing it. We will find a cure for MS, it's not a pipe dream. We're getting there.

It's just a bad week for **KISS**. Just days after Paul Stanley **recovered from a surgery** for his torn bicep tendon, the band's former member and guitarist **Ace Frehley** was admitted to hospital for exhaustion and dehydration.

"Ace Frehley was admitted to Wilkes-Barre General Hospital following his show last night at the F.M. Kirby Center in Wilkes-Barre, PA," Frehley's [Facebook page](#) announced on Saturday, April 16. "After extensive testing, it was determined that Ace's [symptoms](#) were due to exhaustion and dehydration. In consultation with his doctors, Ace, who aside from the exhaustion and dehydration has been given a clean bill of health, has reluctantly agreed to cancel tonight's sold out show at the Chance in Poughkeepsie, NY."

Frehley had previously canceled a concert on April 9 in New Hope, Pennsylvania due to a member of his band's illness. Unlike the New Hope gig, the Poughkeepsie concert is subject to reschedule for September. "Once released from the hospital, Ace will be heading home to Southern California to recuperate. We wish him a speedy recovery," the [Facebook post](#) continued.

On Friday, KISS was forced to perform as a trio as Stanley recuperated. **Gene Simmons** performed with guitarist Tommy Thayer and drummer Eric Singer at the annual Race to Erase MS benefit in Los Angeles.

Jaime Pressly took the stage at the Beverly Hilton on Saturday night in front of a crowd including Gisele Beuvals, Kat Graham, Frances Fisher and Kirby and Rick Hilton to give a special shout out to actress Jamie Lynn Sigler who wasn't able to attend the event, but recently shared she was diagnosed with the disease as well.

"It's the tough thing to do when you are in the limelight to tell people who's wrong, so kudos to her for telling us what's right about MS and the fight and the Race to Erase MS which we are all here for tonight raising money," said Pressly. "That's the only thing celebrity is really good for. That and getting a table when you don't have a reservation."

The evening honored Carolyn Rafaelian, CEO of Alex and Ani, with the Medal of Hope award for her **Charity by Design** initiative which has allowed the foundation to donate over \$26 million to charitable organizations.

David Foster and Eric Benet kicked off the night of entertainment with a moving tribute to Natalie Cole, a frequent supporter of Race to Erase MS. Foster later took the stage again with The Voice winner Jordan Smith to perform. Randy Jackson introduced KISS who rooked the crowd sans Paul Stanley (Jackson said the fourth member was undergoing surgery but will recover in time for the group's summer tour) before all of the artists returned to the stage along with Clay Walker, BC Jean and Emblem3 to perform "Lean on Me" a song that traditionally closes out Davis' show.

The annual benefit has helped raise significant funds towards supporting a "Dream Team" of doctors that have made advances in curing MS, including a new drug which Davis announced during the evening.

"When I was first diagnosed with MS 25 years ago, there was no cause, no cure, no drugs. Now there is finally going to be a drug that helps people with chronic and primary progressive MS," said Davis. "The 14th drug will get FDA approval before the end of the year. This is a life changing situation."

Davis' gala has raised over \$36 million for MS — a disease that Davis was diagnosed with over 20 years ago. Funds raised from the event will go towards the Center Without Walls program established to bring together top doctors in an effort to find a cure for MS.





As the Republican party debates whether or not billionaire frontrunner Donald Trump should snag the presidential nomination this summer at their convention, they have a new opinion to take into consideration. On Monday, Kiss frontman Gene Simmons endorsed Donald Trump as his preferred candidate to take over the Oval Office come next January. Well, sort of.

Ace Frehley, a former KISS member and guitarist, was hospitalized for exhaustion and dehydration at Wilkes-Barre General Hospital in Pennsylvania, according to Frehley's Facebook page on Saturday. The hospitalization caused Frehley to postpone the concert show he had scheduled on Saturday night in Poughkeepsie, New York, according to *Rolling Stone*.

Frehley's bout with dehydration and exhaustion and concert cancellation came just a day after KISS was forced to perform on Friday as a trio for only the second time ever in the band's 40-year career, following a tear to the bicep tendon that guitarist Paul Stanley experienced. Stanley had surgery performed on the tear, according to a tweet he posted on his Twitter account, the *Inquirer* reported. Stanley wrote that the torn bicep was reattached "with a screw and stitches to anchor in place."

The separate and unrelated medical issues that both KISS guitarists faced, causing Frehley to cancel and eventually reschedule the Poughkeepsie concert and Stanley to miss out on playing with his bandmates on Friday night at the Race to Erase MS benefit in Los Angeles, were coincidental, but sad news to their fans. A statement on Ace Frehley's Facebook page said that the famous rock guitarist, other than for his dehydration and case of exhaustion, "has been given a clean bill of health." He had been scheduled to perform at a sold out show at the Chance.


