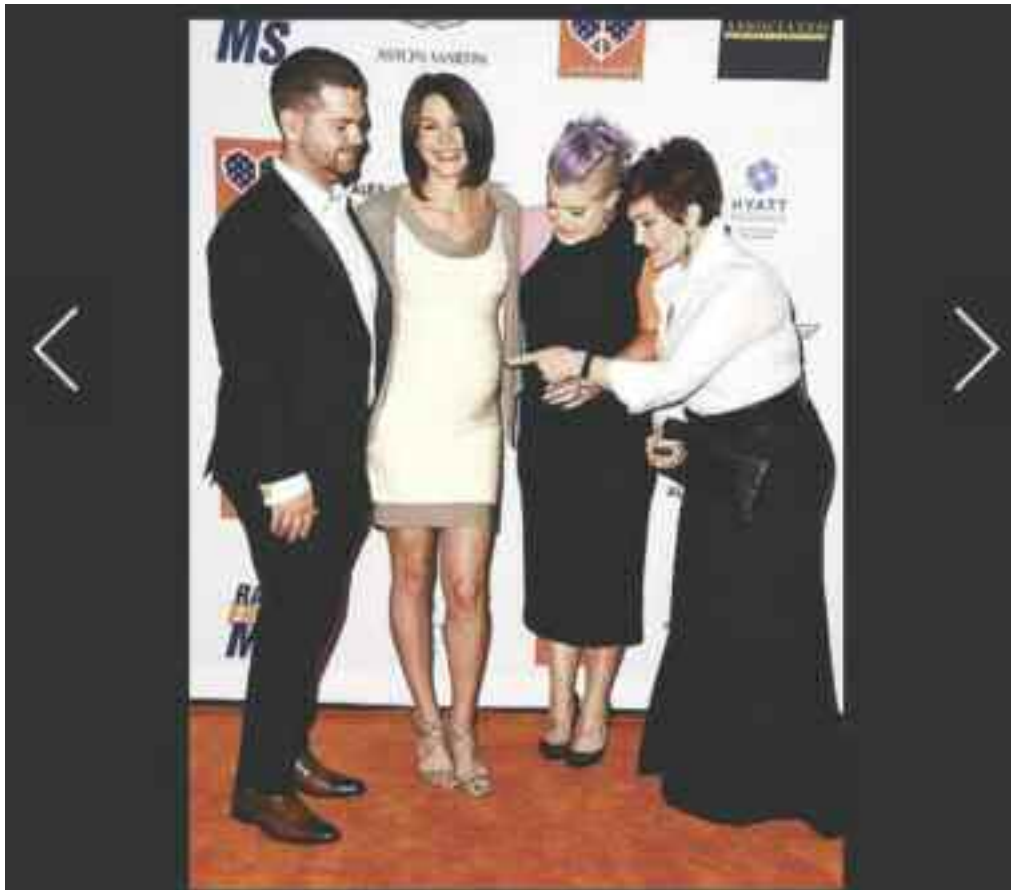

The designer, who will be honored with the Medal of Hope at Friday's Race to Erase MS gala, has always held the cause near and dear to his heart.



It's already been a banner year for **Tommy Hilfiger**, who's celebrating the 30th anniversary of his namesake line, and recently feted the opening of a Paris boutique. Come Friday, Hilfiger adds another milestone to the growing list: He's the Medal of Hope honoree at the 22nd annual **Race to Erase MS** gala in L.A.

Founded by **Nancy Davis** in 1993 following her own diagnosis with multiple sclerosis, the non-profit organization is dedicated to finding a cure for MS — a disease Hilfiger is all-too-familiar with since his own sister's diagnosis. Since 1997, Hilfiger has been committed to the cause — one of a handful that he holds close to his heart and that has helped define his charitable work. "My parents instilled the idea of giving back and caring for others at a really young age," says Hilfiger, who credits his mother's involvement with the local church for instilling his innate sense for giving back and helping others.

"I watched [my sister] really suffer, and I want to make a difference, and to do something to help find a cure," says Hilfiger, who has sponsored the gala's accompanying fashion show in years past. "I knew that by getting involved with Nancy Davis and Race to Erase MS, the money would go towards finding a cure. And it has." Last year's gala alone raised more than \$1.75 million for the cause.

"[Tommy] has helped us raise tremendous funds to support groundbreaking MS research," adds Davis, who befriended Hilfiger more than 20 years ago at an MS fundraiser. "He is a true gentleman with a gigantic heart who defines the true meaning of charity and giving back. We would not have the incredible advances in MS therapies to stop the progression of MS without the iconic Tommy Hilfiger."

Hilfiger admits that 2015 does feel like a special year on a personal level, even more so since he's started ~~writing his autobiography~~, scheduled to hit shelves sometime next year. The book will delve into everything from Hilfiger's early childhood to present day, as well as the highs and lows of being in fashion today. "I really dug in this year and realized, we've done a lot over the last 30 years."

Race To Erase MS Honors Tommy Hilfiger

"It means a lot to my family," Tommy Hilfiger said on the red carpet before accepting an award from the Race to Erase MS Gala held at the Hyatt Regency Century Plaza in Los Angeles last week. "My sister has been affected by [multiple sclerosis]. She's had a very difficult time for many years, but now there's hope for medication to better the lives of many of the people who have it."

The designer and his wife Dee Ocleppo were the first to arrive at host Nancy Davis' annual affair, which has grown tremendously since its inception 22 years ago. "It started out as a very small event and now it's probably one of the most important events in California and maybe the United States," added the longtime supporter, who was presented by his daughter Ally and son Richard with the Medal of Hope award. "It's progressing because they're finding new medications and putting all these doctors together in such a healthy, intelligent way. There are people working together for a change in finding a cure."

For Sharon, Kelly and Jack Osbourne, the family affair has become an equally personal tradition. "When I got diagnosed at 27, I was scared," said Jack of going public with his private battle. "I thought it was a disease that people got much later in life. I couldn't relate to anyone out there and I decided that not enough people were talking about it and that a lot of good could come from me not living in the shadows with it, so I decided to use my voice. It's events like this that really help raise those dollars to fund the research." Added his mother Sharon, "This evening means everything to me."

Ora performed a four-song set. "Sing it with me," she instructed the audience as she launched into her hit "Black Widow." Then Ne-Yo closed out the night. "It's a very serious situation and a very serious matter, but I feel like there's definitely some fun to be had here," he said. "I'm going to try to do my part to make sure everyone has as much fun as I'm going to have as I perform."

The evening raised more than \$1.7 million for the Center Without Walls program's multiple sclerosis research.

Call them the \$135 million fundraising dream team, all members of one family: LAs beloved Davises. Since 1977, matriarch Barbara, 84, has raised nearly \$100 million for the Children's Diabetes Foundation, the nonprofit she and her late mogul husband, Marvin, started after their then-7-year-old daughter, Dana, was diagnosed with juvenile diabetes. Known for her graciousness and tenacity (Everybody says uncle to my mom, jokes daughter Nancy), Barbara throws one of the town's most star-studded and long-standing galas, the biennial Carousel Ball, whose recent humanitarian honorees include George Clooney and Magic Johnson. Nancy, 57, who was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis in 1991, is just as gifted at getting Hollywood to give. Her annual Race to Erase MS gala has brought in more than \$32 million since 1999 to fund research and treatment and to encourage doctors to share information through its Center Without Walls program. Our idea was to get doctors from the seven major research centers together and never to duplicate research, says Nancy. Now Dana, 46, is officially involved in the family's commitment to cures. In January, she became interim director of the Children's Diabetes Foundation. She also reveals that, in addition to diabetes, she was diagnosed with MS three years ago. I'm representing the entire family in all of our diseases, jokes Dana. Both she and her sister are in good health, thanks to enormous strides in the last two decades. Eleven drugs are on the market now that weren't on the market when Nancy was first diagnosed. I've personally been able to use two of them, says Dana. How often do you get the opportunity to thank a family member for something so incredible? Beams Barbara: Let me tell you, my girls are amazing.

Not everyone can pull off a bright orange ball gown, but it works on mega MS philanthropist Nancy Davis. Davis held her 22nd annual (wow!) Race to Erase MS fund-raiser on Friday night, packing the [Hyatt Regency Century Plaza](#) from wall to wall with an energetic crowd. The group was so buzzy she could hardly get it to zip it when she hit the stage. Tommy Hilfiger bounced up there to receive an award presented by his son and daughter. "I accept this on behalf of my sister, who has had MS for 25 years," he said. "She is great in spirit but she suffers." His wife Dee also sported an orange gown. Then Hilfiger brought it back to the lady of the hour. "Nancy Davis carries the orange flag 24/7." The two met at Davis's first fund-raiser in Aspen—she has been raising money and awareness for medical research for MS since she was diagnosed with the disease over 20 years ago. Many of the current drugs that combat the progression of the disease were piloted by her [Center Without Walls](#).

Paris Hilton hit the stage holding a teacup Pomeranian a little bigger than her hand for the live auction. "I just lost my little dog Tinkerbelle," she informed the crowd in between making her "That's Hot" face and smooching the pup. Sharon Osbourne led the heated auction and snapped up the dog for \$17,000. She sat by daughter Kelly and son Jack. [Jack Osbourne](#) was diagnosed with MS in 2012. Another hot ticket on the auction was a Bespoke Aston Martin Vanquish that went for \$155,000.

Rita Ora hit the stage loaded with Bulgari jewels (one of the sparklers went flying while she was singing— "Nobody sweep the floor!" she said, and kept on performing) and she was followed by Ne-Yo, who brought his dancers and their red hotpants. Clearly close to her boyfriend's father, Rita paid tribute to Tommy on her Instagram page after the charity event, writing:

While Rita wowed the crowds in California, she's just as popular back home in the UK.

The Sun claim Simon Cowell is keen to recruit the singer, who joined The Voice for the 2015 series, for the new series of The X Factor, which will kick off with auditions in front of the select panel in the summer.

The report claims Rita would replace Mel B on the X Factor and join remaining judges Simon and Cheryl Fernandez-Versos, who Cowell is said to be desperate to keep hold of, as well as a possible new replacement for Louis Walsh.

Cowell has reportedly run into some trouble with ITV though, who don't want a judge from The Voice. "It's going to be very interesting to see how this all pans out but it could get extremely messy," an insider appealing to The Sun claims. "It's a real battle of wills. ITV see X Factor as vastly superior to The Voice. They don't want a judge who they see as a cast-off, as far as they are concerned, Rita's now out of the picture."

"Simon and I've been determined to push ahead with their plan and still think they can sign her," they added. "Rita's young, she's sexy, she's independent and she's current. He had to get her last year but she turned him down. That has just made him more determined."

A source has told Mail Online that Rita is currently considering different ventures for 2015 and has yet to make a decision about any TV offers.

"Rita has an incredibly busy year ahead with a new album and further acting roles in the pipeline so has to think carefully about what she can commit to," the insider explained.

The singer has already had a try-out on The X Factor, she was a guest judge on the ninth series of the show during the London auditions, sitting alongside Louis, Tulisa and Gary Barlow before permanent judge Nicole Scherzinger was recruited.

Simon told the Daily Star earlier this month that he'd have no hesitation in asking a judge from a rival show to join his series. Pleading that he persuaded Alaska Ocean to leave the BBC's Strictly Come Dancing for his Britain's Got Talent, Simon said: "I saw Rita on The Voice and I thought she was very good. When it comes to asking her over, you know, it's for game."

Rita may play hard to get though, as she told the Daily Star after signing up for The Voice that she chose a spot on that show as she respected its process more.

"I don't know how X Factor works. I was only there as a guest judge for a day. But I watched The Voice a lot, I respected how it came across on TV and I love the way that we get as coaches to do what we want," she explained.

Rita was in Century City, California on Friday night to perform at the 22nd Annual Race To Erase MS Event, held at the Hyatt Regency Century Plaza.

The singer was there to show her support for Tommy Hilgier, the father of her boyfriend Ricky, who was the 2015 Model of Hope honoree at the annual fundraising gala, founded by Henry Davis.

Rita dabbled up to the fashion designer at the event, with the Brit star looking stunning in a tiny pastel style mini dress.

The spotty number featured cut-out detail in the back, while the star teamed the mini with matching thigh-high boots.

She added diamond rings and necklaces to finish off her stage look as she performed for the star-studded crowd.

Earlier in the evening Rita joined Tommy, who has been fundraising for MS research since his sister's diagnosis, and his wife Dee on the orange carpet.

The event, The second annual **Race to Erase MS** gala, hosted by Stacy Davis and honoring fashion designer Tommy Hilfiger, got off to a fast start Friday, as Disney stars G. Hannelius and Rowan Blanchard introduced 12-year-old Internet rapper MallyB to open the show. Held at the Hyatt Regency Century Plaza, the celebrity-studded affair also closed on a high note with performances by Rita Ora and Ne-Yo, and by evening's end, proceeds of \$1.7 million had been raised for research on treatments for multiple sclerosis.

The scene: Paris Hilton stepped onto the stage, cradling a 4-month-old Pomeranian puppy, on offer to the highest bidder. The live auction at dinner, introduced by Anne Heche and James Tupper, also included a 2013 Aston Martin V8 Vantage GT, trips to exotic locales, a dinner for 50 and more. A 600-hot silent auction took place during the cocktail hour, which featured jewelry, accessories, more trips, show tickets, gift baskets, celebrity meet-and-greets and other goodies.

The music: "Are you ready L.A.? Are you ready to kick it off high?" asked Randy Jackson, as he brought out Ora, who delivered her performance in a polka dot mini-dress, marched to polka dot boots. Ne-Yo ended the affair with a set so electric that, as he and his dancers took their final bows, partygoers began taking apart their centerpieces so they could toss them the flowers.

The crowd: Davis and Lynn Palmer chaired the auction, and actors, dancers, reality stars and others filled the ballroom. Among them were Bumer Willis, Willow Shields, Robert Herjavec, Eryn Johnson, Ken Moksepe, Valentin Chmerkovskiy, Tony Danza and Cheryl Burke of "Dancing With the Stars", TV personalities Lisa Vanderpump, Ken Todd, Camille Grammer, Rita Farahan, Keltie Knight, Sharon Osbourne, Jack Osbourne and Kelly Osbourne, Frances Fisher and her daughter Francesca Eastwood, Carmen Electra, Megan Nicole, Lydia Hearst, Katherine McNamara, Aly Michalka, AJ Michalka, Lea Thompson, Clementine Ford, Robert Knepper, Loni Anderson, Barbara Abn Woods, Francesca Capaldi, Tom Guffin, Sandra Taylor and Linda Thompson.

Quotes of note: Hilfiger received the charity's Medal of Hope, and Davis called him "a true American hero."

"He is that rare gentleman who lives up to every promise he makes and then some," said Davis. The daughter of the late Marvin Davis, former owner of 20th Century Fox, Davis founded the charity event after being diagnosed with MS.

For his part, Hilfiger — whose sister has MS — said of Davis, "She is the one who carries the flag 24/7 and really fights for a cure for this disease." He told the audience, "I believe with all your help and your generosity (a cure) will happen in a very short amount of time."

The numbers: An estimated 1,200 guests attended the event, which offered tickets ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,500. As to the auction, the car fetched \$155,000; the puppy, \$15,000.

Diagnosis: Hope

Race to Erase MS founder Nancy Davis talks about how parenting with MS can be done, and why May is the month to wear orange.

I was a mom with three young children when I got the news.

An oval skier, I had been on the slopes in Aspen. There was an accident, and I wound up in a local hospital. Three weeks later, I began to experience numbness in the fingertips on my right hand. Then I lost feeling in the entire hand, then the other hand, and gradually in other parts of my body.

It was 1991. I was 33 years old, and I had just been diagnosed with multiple sclerosis.

A neurologist determined the ski accident had triggered what was already in my body from a young age, but had until then shown no symptoms. I was told I could never work again and would be "lucky" to even operate a TV remote.

I was stunned and terrified, both for myself and, as an unimagined future unfolded before me, at the prospect of being an incapable mother. I couldn't help but wonder if I would be able to participate in any of my children's activities. In fact, I was terrified they would have to push me around in a wheelchair. What I did know was I needed to be honest with them as much as I could without scaring them, and over time I taught them more facts that were age-appropriate. Going from doctor to doctor, city to city. I kept hearing the same thing: MS was a hopeless disease with no known cause, therapies or cure.

But I was determined to fight.

I met medical teams that were all doing the same research, and I realized the pressing need to connect them to share information and unify their efforts. I wanted the doctors to consistently communicate and never duplicate their research, and this became the cornerstone of the Center Without Walls. I established an annual gala to fund these collaborative efforts.

Some 12 years after being diagnosed, I was able to have more children and gave birth to twin daughters. Thankfully, the MS is suppressed during pregnancy, and I'm lucky to now have healthy 10-year-old girls.

As a mother with MS, still quite mobile despite the initial prognosis, raising five children has been a challenge. But it has also been, as they say, a teachable moment. Since running the Race to Erase MS Foundation has required much of my time, I've taught my work and home life together by involving my children in everything I do. They have come to meetings, provided input, helped plan initiatives and regularly solicited auction items for our annual gala. They love being part of this cause, not just because their mom has MS, but because they know there are so many others who suffer from the disease.

My youngest daughters have helped me learn to educate young people and use social media to reach them. They are incredibly insightful. With even the most buttoned-down businesses embracing "gamification" to better reach Millennials, they know that cause-driven foundations also need to make outreach fun.

There's certainly no lack of fun – humor! song! celebrity repartee! – at our April fundraiser. We just held our 22nd annual Race to Erase MS gala, upping our donation base to more than \$36 million raised to date. This segues into May and our "Orange You Happy to Erase MS?" campaign. This month-long campaign was launched in 2008 to heighten awareness and raise funds for MS research. Orange is a vibrant color of hope that was chosen to represent multiple sclerosis. Throughout May, a growing list of partners designs unique orange products which are sold to benefit Race to Erase MS. Many are designed for young people, from fashion to beauty to books, helping educate and inspire the next generation.

My children have given my life deeper meaning, a greater sense of responsibility, and the drive to keep pushing. When I started the foundation more than two decades ago, there were no available drugs. Today, there are 11 FDA-approved drugs, with more coming through the pipeline. Modern research holds tremendous promise in not only diagnosing and treating MS, but in finding a cure. I'm proud to have been part of that progress. And I hope my journey can empower others to make choices, even ones they don't believe they have. I have found my PIL (purpose in life), and believe this is more important to me than any pill a doctor can ever give me to improve my health.

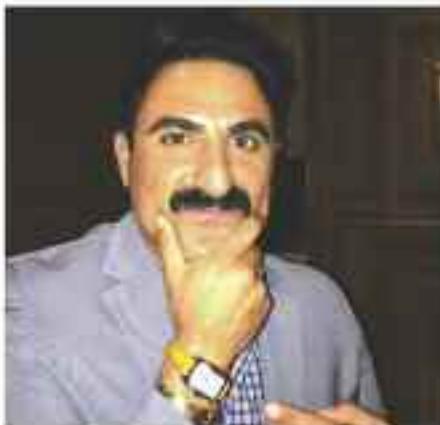

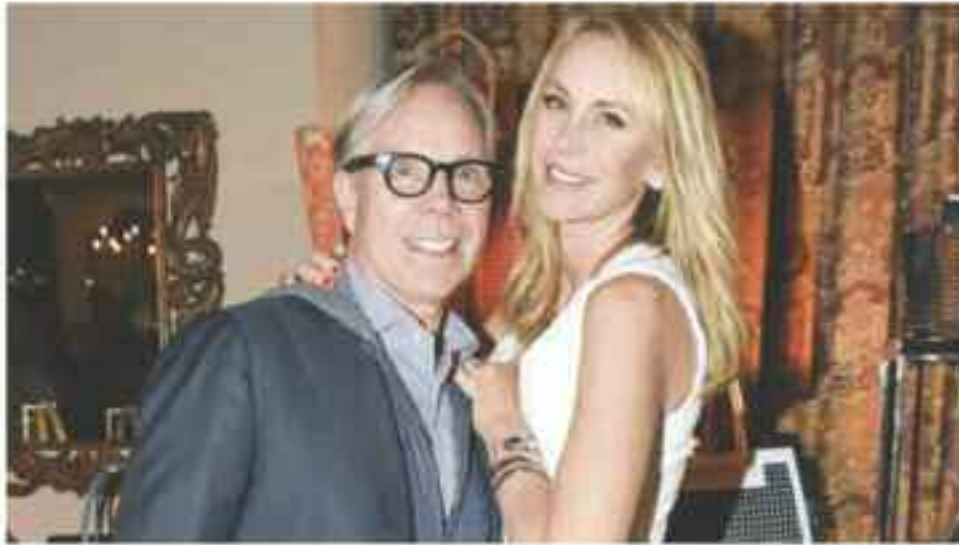
